Solon, Herodotus, Thales, Pythagoras had visited and studied the Egyptian civilization before contributing in the development of the Greek civilization.

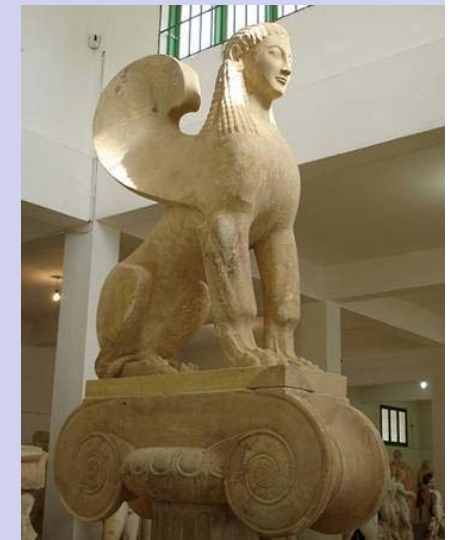
Later on, the Romans were influenced by the ancient Greeks.
